Working in close cooperation with other scholars, the successful applicant will be required to demonstrate significant academic contribution to the research project “Industrial Skills Development and Technical and Vocational Education in Africa” and to conduct administrative works including the arrangement of field visits in Japan for overseas’ trainees and an international symposium.

 - 1) To hold a doctor’s degree in the field of Education, Economics, Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, and other relevant field (an eligible applicant includes the one expecting to acquire a doctor’s degree by the starting date of employment)
 - 2) To be able to academically contribute to the research on technical and vocational education and training (TVET), employment, and skills assessment of workers in Africa, with a firm disciplinary basis
 - 3) Desirable to have research experience in developing countries, particularly in Africa
6. Term of appointment: Fixed term between December 1, 2016, and March 31, 2017
7. Conditions:
 - 1) Working hours: discretionary
 - 2) Holidays: Saturdays and Sundays, Japanese National Holidays, year-end and New Year (Dec. 29 - Jan. 3), summer holidays, paid holidays
