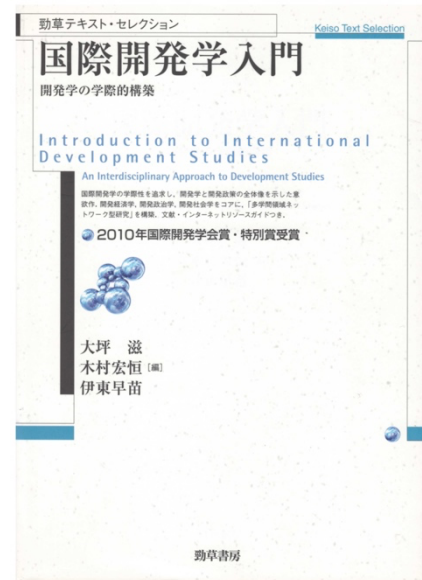

Hi. Welcome to GSID. Welcome to I2ID.

Due to my vision disability (and COVID-19), I will broadcast my lecture on “Introduction to International Development Studies: From the Viewpoint of Development Economics” to the GSID Auditorium on April 19 on ZOOM.

The reading materials (*Introduction* and *Chapter 1* of the *I2ID Book*), a PowerPoint presentation file (provided in a PDF), and a Table that summarizes the evolution in *Development Paradigms and Economists' Reasons for Poverty* will be provided through the I2ID TA, the TACT I2ID Account, or through the Otsubo Seminar HP. Here are the instructions that you should follow, step by step:



STEP 1: Getting to the I2ID Resource Box and *I2ID Book* HP

Go to Prof. Otsubo Seminar HP at <http://www.gsid.nagoya-u.ac.jp/sotsubo/>

Go down to the Yellow I2ID Resource Box at the bottom of the cover page, and click on “I2ID Book” to enter the *I2ID Book* HP. There you see English manuscripts for the Part I of the *I2ID Book*.

STEP 2: Reading Two Required Chapters from the *I2ID Book*

In the *I2ID Book* HP, download and read “Introduction to International Development Studies” and “Chapter 1: From the Viewpoint of Development Economics” in this order. (Required Readings)

For you to open these files you need to use the following Password: xxxxxxx (case sensitive)

You are NOT allowed to pass on the manuscripts or the password to the third party. (copyright)

STEP 3: Download and Go Through a PowerPoint File and a Summary Table (provided in the same I2ID Box)

After reading these two required chapters, go back to the Yellow I2ID Resource Box and download and go through the I2ID PowerPoint Presentation Files. I inserted messages in the slides as much as possible for a self-guided self-study. (This file is heavy due to usages of photos inside.)

Finally download and check the Table: *Evolution in Development Paradigms and Economists' Reasons for Poverty*. You will find the reasons in the last row of this table.

(I will use this PowerPoint Presentation File and the Table in my April 19 Lecture.)
