**Notice of changes to the English test
in the entrance examination for the Master's Program**

As of September 2019, the English language test portion of the entrance examination for the Master's Program, Graduate School of International Development (GSID), Nagoya University, will be changed as follows:

Current rules (for the entrance examination to be conducted in February 2019)

- Applicants must choose and answer one question each from Categories 1 and 2.
- Category 1 is composed of **Question 1A** (summary of English text) and **Question 1B** (English to Japanese translation)
- Category 2 is composed of five questions from which applicants have to choose one to answer: **Question 2A** (economics), **Question 2B** (education), **Question 2C** (law), **Question 2D** (political science), and **Question 2E** (social development).

Updated rules (for the entrance examinations to be conducted in September 2019 and February 2020)

- The examination will be composed of Categories 1 and 2.
- Category 1 is required for all applicants, which is to summarize an English text.
- Category 2 is composed of two questions from which applicants have to choose one to answer: **Question 2A** (summary of English text) and **Question 2B** (English to Japanese translation).
